

Redwood Youth Soccer League Spring 2015 Registration

Registration for Spring 2015 CalNorth Soccer is now open for all Fall 2014 teams and new Spring 2015 teams that are U08 and older.

Spring registration packets are due to the RWL Registrar by **Saturday, February 28, 2015**.

2015 Spring Registration Overview:

- Please upload all registration materials (1601 forms, POA's and photos) to the RWL site.
- If your team plans to participate in a tournament in the spring or summer (other than State Cup or District Cup), please note this on the team transmittal. A Spring "Secondary" roster cannot be used for such tournaments.
- All RWL team transmittals must include the correct age group and team number
- When adding adults to team transmittals, please provide their given names (i.e. name on drivers license, passport, birth certificate)
- If you plan to use the fall roster for the spring season and have no changes, please note it on your transmittal.
- All new players must submit a copy of their birth certificate or passport with their 1601 registration form.
- All changes to fall rosters must include a signed 1606 Roster Change request form and return of the player's existing pass. Spring roster creation and/or changes do not require any paperwork other than an updated team transmittal, unless a player not registered in the 2014 fall is being added to the roster.

2015 Spring RWL Registration Procedures

Team Rosters:

Teams may participate in the CalNorth spring league with their Fall 2014 Rosters or with spring "Secondary" Rosters. A Secondary Roster can be made up of previously registered players from different Cal North teams and or newly registered players. Secondary Rosters cannot be used for Cal North Tournaments. Teams are allowed guest players for spring league games, as long as the players are registered within the Redwood League.

- U14 & older: minimum player count is 13 to register; roster max is 22
- U12-U13 teams: min player count is 13 to register; roster max is 18
- U11 & younger: min player count is 10 to register; roster max is 18

2015 Spring Registration for all teams registered with CalNorth in the Fall, 2014:

- The Fall 2014 roster and existing player passes will be used
- Any changes to the Fall 2014 roster will require 1606 Roster Change paperwork
- Teams using Fall Rosters **MAY** participate in CalNorth Tournaments

2015 Spring Registration for all new teams NOT registered with CalNorth in the Fall, 2014, OR existing Fall 2014 teams that wish to participate with a Secondary Roster:

- Secondary Team Rosters can contain newly registered players, existing players from Fall Rosters, or a mixture of both. All secondary rosters should be developed on the RWL site (www.redwoodsoccer.org) and the team transmittal is then submitted for registration.
- A completed 1601 Registration Form and birth document is required for any new player not registered in Fall, 2014.
- Players may be added or transferred between secondary rosters without the use of 1606 Roster Change paperwork...just provide an updated team transmittal form.
- A team Secondary Roster and player / adult passes will be produced by the League Registrar. Photos may be uploaded into the RWL site so they may be printed on the passes.
- Teams using spring Secondary Rosters **MAY NOT** participate in CalNorth Tournaments

CCSL Spring League Play for all Redwood League Teams:

Team playing league registration must be done separately on the www.GotSoccer.org site. CCSL Spring League Applications close Monday, February 24.

Team Registration:

The Preferred method for the Spring 2015 registration is for all documents (1601s & PoA) to be uploaded onto the Redwood Site www.redwoodsoccer.org. The team can then complete the Transmittal on the Redwood Site. The Club Registrar should then notify the League Registrar of the completion and the League Registrar will then complete the registration into the Affinity system.

On an exception basis, if the team registering needs to use a packet, the packet should include:

- For Fall and Secondary Rosters:
 - One (1) copy of the team transmittal from the RWL registration site. The team transmittal should reflect that payment has been made for all players and staff shown on the transmittal. (For teams using their Fall Roster and have no changes to the roster, or for teams using a Secondary Roster containing players and staff members that were registered in Fall 2014, this is the only document needed for Spring Registration.)
 - One (1) copy each of a signed 1601 Registration Form and a birth verification document for each **new** player not registered in Fall, 2014.
 - Evidence of staff completion of the Team Official Registration and Risk Management Disclosure Form (**FORM #1650**) for each adult not registered in Fall, 2014. The online form can be found at http://www.calnorth.org/programs/registration/adult_online_disclosure/
- For Fall Rosters only:
 - 1606 Roster Change Form documentation for any roster changes.

All staff members (18 and older) must complete the Fingerprint Background Check program through Capital Live Scan. This is a one-time process, so those who were team rosters in the fall do not need to repeat. **The adult name on the Livescan & Transmittal must be the Full Legal Name of the adult and match exactly.** (Go to http://www.capitallivescan.com/soccer_walk_in.html for additional information.)

Redwood League Spring Fees:

- \$30 per team
- \$15 per NEW player (not registered in Fall, 2014)
- \$10 per NEW adult (not registered in Fall, 2014) per team

All Redwood League fee payments must be made through the Redwood League site via PayPal. Proof of payment will be shown on the team transmittal.
